SEATTLE DEAF FILM FESTIVAL CALLING FOR FILM ENTRIES

Seattle, WA- The Seattle Deaf Film Festival (SDFF) is announcing their call for entries and information regarding eligibility and entry deadlines for the 2012 SDFF event, taking place from March 30 - April 1, 2012 at the University of Washington.

Eligibility for the Festival is currently limited to Deaf filmmakers ("Deaf" includes Deaf, Deaf-Blind, Hard of Hearing, and CODA). Filmmakers can submit a feature or short film in a variety of genres: Documentary, Drama, Animation, Suspense/Action or Comedy/Musical. Films that are not in ASL must be subtitled and/or captioned in English. Films that are entirely in ASL may be submitted with or without subtitles/captions in English.

The Seattle Deaf Film Festival will begin accepting submissions beginning August 15, 2011. The deadline for film submissions is November 30, 2011. Submissions postmarked after this date will not be accepted. Additional eligibility guidelines and associated entry fees are available on the website now.
